

TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

CAMO Leather

We use CAMO furniture leather which is a semi aniline type that is flexible and soft with an elegant look. The top is slightly corrected and has a thin protective layer. Slight differences between different leather hides are very common. Semi aniline leather will gain small imperfections, discoloration and marks over time leaving a patina on the furniture.

Maintenance

Since leather is a natural material, it needs some care to ensure its long-lasting appeal year after year, generation after generation.

We recommend that you follow the steps to maintain the leather:

- Avoid placing the leather in direct sunlight or exposing it to extreme heat.
- If you spill something on your furniture, use a dry cloth immediately to dab off any excess liquid.
- Use a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush to remove dust. A cloth and a mild soap solution can be used to remove dirt and grime.
- If needed, for semi-aniline leather, use a leather protection cream to offer more protection against staining and scratching. This may alter the color of the leather. When applying recommended creams always pay attention to the instructions and test on an inconspicuous area first.

Please avoid using any harsh detergents or solvents when cleaning the product.
