GABRIEL POLYESTER FABRIC TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

The material on your furniture is made of polyester from Gabriel, it is particularly easy to maintain, and spots can be removed easily and without problems.

The most environmentally correct production processes also ensure you a healthy and sustainable product.

Easy maintenance

To preserve the fabric's attractive colour and appearance, we recommend regular vacuuming, preferably every week, with a soft fitting.

Important points about spot removal

- A golden rule: always remove the spot as quickly as possible before it penetrates into the fibres.
- Most types of spots can be removed with lukewarm water, possibly with a pH-neutral dishwashing detergent.
- Avoid soaking as this can damage the material under the fabric.
- Never rub hard to remove a spot.
- Use only the cleaning methods specified in the spot guide.


 Always use a clean white cotton cloth with only small amounts of detergent at a time.

N.B.! Benzene/acetone and similar can dissolve foam on soaking. Be careful with naked flames. Hazardous when inhaled. Follow the guidelines from the supplier of the product.

Proceed as follows

- First absorb as much of the liquid as possible with plain white kitchen paper towelling or a cloth.
- If the spot has dried, remove as much as possible by vacuuming.
- Rub gently with a clean white cloth.
- Press a dry tea towel or piece of plain white kitchen roll against the fabric each time liquid is added so that moisture and impurities are absorbed.
- Use pure water without soap for the last washing.
